1. Center for International Cooperation

Center for International Cooperation operates for foreigners who have completed high school or higher in a foreign country or for foreigners living in Korea. Students are divided into separate classes according to their language level.

We provide high-quality Korean language education to students so that they can improve their Korean language skills, advance to university, and realize their dreams in Korea.

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The main purpose of our university's Korean language course is to improve the Korean communication skills of international students. The Korean language course consists of speaking, listening, reading, and writing programs.

- Those who do not have any disqualifications for visa issuance (D-4-1, etc.) that allows admission to a Korean language school
- Others: Those recognized by the Director of the Global Education Center as special course students

Selection Criteria and Evaluation Rate

Selection Criteria	Evaluation Rate	Details
Documents screening	100% (100 Marks)	Comprehensively evaluate the applicant's submitted language skills, academic performance, and other documents. ※ If necessary, an interview (face-to-face or video) will be conducted and reflected in the evaluation.

▶ Selection Criteria

1. Selection will be made in order of the total score of the typical evaluation. However, if it is determined that the required level of mathematical ability is not met, selection may not be made.
2. Criteria for handling tied scores: All tied scores will be selected
3. If the submitted documents are not complete or if there are false facts in the submitted documents, the applicant will be disqualified.

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■ **Dormitory Fee:** 6,500 ~ 8,200 KRW per day

- Priority will be given to degree program international students, and remaining rooms will be assigned accordingly. Dormitory fees are included in the tuition upon application.

■ **Application Fee:** 20,000 KRW

- Included in the tuition and issued on the tuition invoice.

■ **Insurance Fee:** 70,000 KRW

- Insurance for international students' safety after arrival (valid for up to 3 months before enrolling in the National Health Insurance). The fee is included in the tuition, and an invoice will be issued.

■ **Other Expenses (Cash Payment After Arrival)**

- **Alien Registration Fee:** 35,000 KRW
- **Bank Account Issuance Fee:** 1,000 KRW
- **Various Certificate Issuance Fees:** 1,000 KRW
- **Textbook Fees, etc.,** to be paid separately after arrival.

★ **Invoice will be issued after admission confirmation.**

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According to the National Health Insurance Act and its enforcement regulations, all international students are required to enroll as regional subscribers of the National Health Insurance starting from March 2021. (Enrollment begins immediately after completing foreigner registration upon arrival.) ※ Detailed information will be provided only to enrolled students.
